EQUINE FLU RULE

Each exhibit must be vaccinated against equine flu, with the exception of foals.
Passports must be shown when collecting numbers.

Animals must be entered correctly in line with the rules, detailed in the WPCS Judging and Showing Handbook which can be found on the Society website www.wpcs.uk.com or requested from the WPCS office. Failure to comply with the rules may result in the withholding of awards.

Your Personal Data

Exhibitor you will need to provide the WPCS with certain personal information relating to you. Your privacy is extremely important to WPCS, so we want you to know exactly how we will use that personal information. Rules

When transporting your Horses, Ponies & Cobs you are required by law to have their equine passports with you.

We want our Members and Competitors to spend a thoroughly enjoyable and safe day with us, therefore we respectfully ask that the following rules be adhered to for the benefit of all who attend.

Rules

1. All exhibits must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society OR relevant breed society in the case of M&M exhibits.
2. No telephone or email entries will be accepted.
3. All entries must be paid before the animal will be allowed to enter the ring.
4. All colts and stallions two years old and over must be suitably bitted and led by a handler who has attained his/her 14th birthday before 1st of January of the current year.
5. Animals and property will be considered as being in the exhibitor's charge.
6. Children and dogs must be supervised at all times.
7. The Committee will not in any way be responsible for loss, damage or injury owing to accident or other cause.
8. The Committee reserves the rights to postpone, alter, cancel, divide or combine without notice, any or all events.
9. Any objection must be lodged in writing with the secretary within 30 minutes of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £25, which shall be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.
10. Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring.
11. A Barren Mare is a mare who has not produced a foal, dead or alive, and will not produce a foal in the current year.
12. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to get him/herself into the ring at the correct time.
13. No refunds will be given under any circumstances.
14. Classes will not be held up for competitors who are exhibiting in more than one section.
15. The judge's decision is final.
16. The show expects all exhibitors to have their own third party insurance. In the event of an accident any damages will be the handler/owners responsibility.
17. Any person(s) on the show ground who are acting in an unfit or abusive manner towards other competitors, spectators, judges, secretary, officials or animals will be asked to leave the show ground and no entry fee will be refunded.
18. Trimming/ clipping – Its acceptable for Welsh to have the hair trimmed under the jaw line and protruding from the ears. Animals four years and over can be body clipped for work purposes. NO youngsters shall be body clipped. NO ANIMALS should have their sensory whiskers removed.

Medal Awards (if applicable)

1. Medals will only be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion.
2. No animal shall be awarded more than one Medal in one year. Medals awarded at the Royal Welsh Show are exempted from this rule.
3. Medals will only be awarded to animals whose owners are members of the Welsh Pony & Cob Society, who have paid their subscription for the current year or are Life Members, or who have submitted their name for membership and paid one annual subscription or Life Membership composition.

Ridden Classes

1. All entries must be registered with the Welsh Pony and Cob Society OR relevant breed society in the case of M&M exhibits.
2. Spurs must not be worn in any class.
3. Show canes/whips are not to exceed 75cm. In lead rein classes, only plain or leather covered canes may be used.
4. Hard hats to the approved BSI standard must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
5. Any exhibit considered not to be under adequate control will be asked to leave the ring.
6. Animals must be four years old or over.
7. Riders of Welsh Section A, B, C and Welsh Part Bred stallions, 14.2 hh and under must have attained their 12th birthday prior to 1st of January in the current year.
8. Riders of Welsh Section D and Welsh Part Bred stallions, over 14.2 hh, must have attained their 14th birthday prior to 1st of January in the current year.
9. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday prior to 1st of January in the current year.
10. Lead rein ponies must be shown in snaffle bridle only, with lead rein attached to the noseband.
11. First ridden ponies may be shown in any suitable snaffle.
12. Snaffle bridles only may be worn in novice classes.
13. Prize money – At the discretion of the Committee.
14. The judge's decision is final.

**All entries must be paid before the animal will be allowed to enter the ring. No entries will be accepted by phone or email.
By entering and exhibiting, you are agreeing to abide by the TRWPCA rulings.**

TGCA breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Associations (TGCA) National Breed championship Show 'TOYS'. Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Current TGCA members must present their membership card and qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non members MUST receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification.

The Greatest Gelding Award - Traditional Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level. **This Award should be given to the highest placed registered Traditional Gelding (must be current TGCA Member).**

69. Lead Rein

Open to M&M Small Breeds and Part Bred Mare/Gelding, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 121.9cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies to be shown in a snaffle bridle - The reins must go directly from the bit to the child's hands with no extra aid or attachment to or on the saddle. The reins must be of normal length and not knotted or stitched together at a shorter length. Handles on saddles are permitted but the reins must not be attached to the handle of the saddle. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband only with reins to go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. The lead rein must be attached to the noseband only.

70. First Ridden

Open to M&M Small Breeds and Part Bred Mare/Gelding, 4yrs old and over not exceeding 128cm. Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Ponies are to be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle. The reins must be of normal length and not knotted or stitched together at a shorter length. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show.
